**July 15, 2014 - Abuse and Neglect
Reporting**

Employees need to be able to understand abuse and related terms and identify individuals who are vulnerable to become victims of abuse. Know your obligations under the Elder Justice Act of 2009. Learn the general reporting procedures for suspected cases of abuse or neglect.

August 19, 2014 - Ethics

Ensure that your key employees are able to define ethics and other applicable terms. Understand the need for patient confidentiality; be able to identify discrimination and conflicts of interest.
